



## Philadelphia and Washington (4 days/3 nights)

#### Itinerary (subject to modifications without prior notice):

##### Day 1

**06:00am:** Departure from Montreal (Alexis Nihon Place, 4001 blvd de Maisonneuve West). **\*\*No exceptions\*\***

Stop at the Duty Free.

Stop for breakfast/break.

Stop for lunch/break.

**04:00pm:** Arrive in Philadelphia and check-in at the hotel in the heart of the city.

**05:00pm:** Walking tour of the downtown, around the magnificent City Hall, followed by free time.

##### Day 2

**07:00am to 08:00am:** Breakfast.

**08:00am:** Departure from the hotel with your luggage and orientation bus of "The City of Brotherly Love".

**10:00am:** Guided tour in English (translated into French) of the jail "Eastern State Penitentiary", one of Al Capone's numerous "homes".

**11:30am:** Departure towards Washington, DC, and a lunch on the way.

**04:00pm:** Arrive in Washington with a walking tour between the White House and the American Parliament, the Capitol.

**06:00pm:** Check-in at the hotel in downtown.

**07:00pm:** Diner and free time in the Dupont Circle district, the heart of Washington's nightlife.

**09:00pm:** Return to the hotel.

##### Day 3

**07:30am to 08:30am:** Breakfast.

**08:30am:** Departure from the hotel for the visit of the Arlington military cemetery, including the graves of the Kennedy brothers, John Fitzgerald and Robert.

**11:00am:** Free time to visit one of the numerous free museums of the Smithsonian Institute, such as the Air and Space Museum, where you could see the Spirit of St. Louis de Charles Lindbergh and the control module of Apollo 11. Free time for lunch at the museums.

**05:00pm:** Dinner and free time in Georgetown, animated district of Washington, where can be found the famous Catholic University of Georgetown.

**07:30pm:** Walking tour of several monuments from the National Mall, at the moment where they are illuminated: Vietnam and Korean wars monuments, as well as the massive Lincoln Memorial.

**09:30pm:** Return to the hotel.

##### Day 4

**07:30am to 08:30am:** Breakfast

**08:30am:** Departure from the hotel with luggage towards Montreal.

Stop for lunch/break.

Stop for dinner/break.

**09:30pm:** Arrival in Montreal (Alexis Nihon Place – 4001 blvd. De Maisonneuve West).
